

GRANT OF ELECTRIC UTILITY LINE EASEMENT

and other considerations  
For and in consideration of the sum of \$ 1.00, in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned owner, sometimes herein referred to as Grantor, hereby grants and conveys unto the CITY OF HARRIMAN, TENNESSEE, for the use and benefit of The Harriman Utility Board, an arm of said City, herein sometimes referred to as Grantee, a perpetual easement over and across certain hereinafter described real estate, said easement being 30 feet in width, lying 15 feet on either side of the following described center line:

Begin at a power pole (PP1) in an existing line on the north bank of old flat fork rd. approximately 50 ft. NE of a culvert and 167.0 ft. S86°12'W of a Iron Pipe, said pipe being the SE corner of the Baley Fred Allred 111 property. Thence along the old rd. N73°13'E, 202.5 ft. to (PP2) at the intersection of a newly cut road; thence continue along the old road S69°35'E, 233.1 ft. to (PP3); thence continue S69°35'E, 30 ft. to the end of the branch line. From (PP2) proceed N29°44'E, 248 ft. to (PP4); thence S74°21'E, 244 ft. to (PP5); thence continue S74°21'E, 30 to the end of branch line. From (PP4), said pole being on the westerly side of the new road and being approximately 42 ft. south of the TVA lines, proceed N18°25'E, 256.4 ft. to (PP6), said pole (PP6) is N28°44'E, 58.74 ft. from the NE corner of the Cagley property; thence N17°50'E, 255 ft. to (PP7); thence N9°27'W, 348 ft. to (PP8), said pole being N56°16'W, 143.7 ft. from the Aytes property corner at a chain link fence, thence continue N17°50'E, 30 ft. to the end of the easement.

for the purpose of installing, operating and maintaining an electric distribution line, including rights of ingress and egress to and from said line for the purpose of clearing, repairing and doing whatever is necessary for efficient operation of said line upon and over the following described property:

Situated in the 4 Civil District of Morgan County, Tennessee, and more particularly described as follows: District 4

Beginning at iron stake beside a 16 ft. white fence, about 50' W of the deciding line of the Young's and the Aytes lands, (roadway between) thence N 82° W 472 ft. to the Redmon line fence, iron stake driven. Thence S 17° E 360 ft. to I. S. in Redmon fence, thence S 82° E 412 ft. to I. S., on W side of road. Thence W the W side of said roadway N 1° 30' W 122 ft. to an I.S. at the curve in the roadway. Thence N 33° E 100 ft. to I. S. on W side of road, thence N 1° 30' W 131.5 ft. to the beginning approx. 4 acres more or less. Ref. to tax map 97, Parcel 13.03

Being a part of that property conveyed to the undersigned by deed of record in Deed Book G7, Page 193, Office of the Register for Morgan County, Tennessee,

which line is to serve the abovedescribed property and other property or properties.

This conveyance is made subject to the following restrictions, which shall run with the land:

A. No building or other structures, other than fences, will be constructed or located within the described easement area and no trees are to be planted within said easement area.

B. Initial right of way clearing shall be performed by the Grantor in the following manner:

All trees shall be removed and underbrush cleared so that the right of way will be clear from the ground up within the 30 ft. width. Trees bordering the right of way on either side shall be trimmed symmetrically unless otherwise specified. Dead trees located outside of the right of way but within proximity thereof, which would strike the line in falling, shall be removed. Leaning trees which would require topping, if not removed, shall either be removed or topped.

C. If underground facilities are to be installed, initial right of way clearing shall be performed by the Grantor in the following manner:

All trees shall be removed and underbrush cleared, with all stumps, rocks and other obstructions, removed and the easement graded to within two inches of final grade over the entire width of said required right of way.

D. The Grantee shall have the right to trim or cut any tree or shrub and at anytime remove any obstruction placed on said right of way to avoid interference with the safe and efficient operation of its facilities.
