GAS LINE EASEMENT

THIS INSTRUMENT, made and entered into on this the 19th day of July, 1969, by and between Jake Vann and wife, Rubye Vann, hereinafter referred to as grantors, and Gertrude Hyder, hereinafter referred to as grantee.

WITNESSETH:

That the said grantors, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, cash in hand paid, and other good and valuable considerations, receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, the grantors do hereby sell, transfer and convey unto the said grantee, her heirs and assigns an easement over and across the following described land, lying and being in the First Civil District, City of Harriman, Roane County, Tennessee, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the gas service connection at the rear of City Recreation Building, and running Eastwardly along the rear of said building, always far enough away from said building so as not to disturb the foundation of said building and extending to the East property line of grantors.

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TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement to the said grantee, her heirs and assigns, as a gas line easement, with the right to install necessary gas lines, remove or repair as required.
