cash in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we, the undersigned,

CONSOLIDATED WATER COMPANY, Inc.

have this day bargained and sold, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer, and convey unto the United States of America, a permanent easement and right-of-way, for the following purposes, namely: the perpetual right to enter and to erect, maintain, repair, rebuild, operate, and patrol one or more electric power transmission lines, and one or more telephone and/or telegraph lines, including the right to erect such poles and other transmission line structures, wires, cables, and any necessary appurtenances; the right to clear said right-of-way and keep the same clear of brush, timber, inflammable structures, and fire hazards; and the right to remove danger trees, if any, located beyond the limits of said right-of-way; all over, upon, across, and under the following described land, to-wit:

A certain tract of land located in the First Civil District and in the City of Harriman, Roane County, Tennessee, containing ____ acres, more or less, and being the same property conveyed to the Consolidated Water Company, Inc., by the Tennessee Utilities Corporation, by a special warranty deed dated 23 September 1941, and recorded in Deed Book T-5, Page 543, in the Register's Office of Roane County, Tennessee.

The easement and right-of-way hereby granted covers a strip of land 100 in width across the above described lands, and is more particularly located and described as follows:

TRACT NO. HP-4

A strip of land for a transmission line right of way 100 feet wide, lying 50 feet on each side of the center line of the Harriman-Petros transmission line location, in the First Civil District of Roane County, Tennessee, as shown on a map filed in the Recorder's office of Roane County, through the land of the Tennessee Utilities Corporation, the center line of the location through the land of the Tennessee Utilities Corporation being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the center line crosses the southwest line of the Tennessee Utilities Corporation's land, which is the northeast line of the Martha Ayres Rockwell Mairs' land, at survey station 11: + 11: on the center line of

the transmission line location, said point being N. 50° 40° W., 171 feet from a hub, a corner of the lands of the Tennessee Utilities Corporation, and the Martha Ayres Rockwell Heirs; thence N. 35° 56° E., 361 feet to a point where the center line crosses the northeast line of the Tennessee Utilities Corporation's land, which is the southwest line of Tom Evans' land, at survey station 18 + 05, said point being S. 34° 08° E., 4.5 feet from a railroad iron, a corner of the lands of the Tennessee Utilities Corporation, and Tom Evans.

The above described strip of land is a continuous right of way through said property between the above named southwest and northeast property lines and has a net length of 361 feet along the center line, and contains 0.8 acre, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement and right-of-way to the United States of America, its successors and assigns, forever.

We covenant with the said United States of America that we are lawfully seized and possessed of said real estate, have a good and lawful right to convey the same, that the same is free of all encumbrances, and that we will forever warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

We do further covenant and agree that the payment of the purchase price above stated is accepted by us as full compensation for all damage incidental to the exercise of any of the rights above described, including any depreciation in the value of the land resulting from the granting of this easement; EXCEPT that the United States of America shall remain liable for any additional damage which may be caused to the property of the undersigned by its construction forces or by the construction forces of its agents and employees, in the erection and maintenance of said lines.
