

# GRANT OF TRANSMISSION LINE EASEMENT

HR-12 & 14

FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of

ONE HUNDRED NINETY-THREE and 86/100----- Dollars (\$ 193.86 ),  
cash in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we, the undersigned,

MRS. ANNIE ISHAM

have this day bargained and sold, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer, and convey unto the United States of America, a permanent easement and right-of-way, for the following purposes, namely: the perpetual right to enter and to erect, maintain, repair, rebuild, operate, and patrol one or more electric power transmission lines, and one or more telephone and/or telegraph lines, including the right to erect such poles and other transmission line structures, wires, cables, and any necessary appurtenances; the right to clear said right-of-way and keep the same clear of brush, timber, inflammable structures, and fire hazards; and the right to remove danger trees, if any, located beyond the limits of said right-of-way; all over, upon, across, and under the following described land, to-wit:

A certain tract or parcel of land situated in the First Civil District of Roane County, Tennessee, and being the same land described in the deed to Annie Isham from Alice M. Martin and Sarah F. Martin dated September 29, 1925, and recorded in Deed Book W-4, page 310, in the Register's office of Roane County, Tennessee, to which deed reference is hereby made for a more particular description of said land.



The easement and right-of-way hereby granted covers a strip of land 100 feet in width across the above described lands, and is more particularly located and described as follows:

TRACT NO. HR-12: A strip of land for a right of way lying in the First Civil District of Roane County, Tennessee, as shown on a map entitled "Harriman-Rockwood Transmission Line" filed in the office of the Register of Roane County, said strip being 100 feet wide, lying 50 feet on each side of the base line of a survey for a transmission line location, the base line of the survey being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the base line crosses the center line of a road, which is the east line of Annie Isham's land and the west line of James A. G. Delozier's land, at survey station 145 + 08 on the base line of the survey, said point being 550 feet, as measured along the center line of the road in a southerly direction, from a corner of the lands of Annie Isham, and James A. G. Delozier; thence S. 60° 01' W., 134.4 feet to a point where the base line crosses a fence line, which is the southwest line of Annie Isham's land and the northeast line of Sarah F. Martin et al's land, at survey station 158 + 52, said point being S. 32° 59' E., 73.4 feet from a corner of the lands of Annie Isham, and Sarah F. Martin et al.

The above described strip of land is a continuous right of way 100 feet wide through the said property between the above named east and southwest property lines and has a net length of 134.4 feet along the base line.



TRACT NO. HR-14: A strip of land for a right of way lying in the First Civil District of Roane County, Tennessee, as shown on a map entitled "Harriman-Rockwood Transmission Line" filed in the office of the Register of Roane County, said strip being 100 feet wide, lying 50 feet on each side of the base line of a survey for a transmission line location, the base line of the survey being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the base line crosses a fence line, which is the southeast line of Annie Isham's land and the northwest line of Sarah F. Martin et al's land, at survey station 160 + 35 on the base line of the survey, said point being S. 36° 33' W., 195 feet from a corner of the lands of Annie Isham, and Sarah F. Martin et al; thence S. 60° 01' W., 235.4 feet to survey station 162 + 70.4; thence S. 62° 31' W., 113.6 feet to a point where the base line crosses the southwest line of Annie Isham's land, which is the northeast line of Sarah F. Martin's land, at survey station 163 + 84, said point being N. 31° 17' W., 154 feet from a corner of the lands of Annie Isham, Sarah F. Martin et al, and Sarah F. Martin.

The above described strip of land is a continuous right of way 100 feet wide through the said property between the above named southeast and southwest property lines and has a net length of 349 feet along the base line.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easement and right-of-way to the United States of America, its successors and assigns, forever.

We covenant with the said United States of America that we are lawfully seized and possessed of said real estate, have a good and lawful right to convey the same, that the same is free of all encumbrances, and that we will forever warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

We do further covenant and agree that the payment of the purchase price above stated is accepted by us as full compensation for all damage incidental to the exercise of any of the rights above described, including any depreciation in the value of the land resulting from the granting of this easement; EXCEPT that the United States of America shall remain liable for any additional damage which may be caused to the property of the undersigned by its construction forces or by the construction forces of its agents and employees, in the erection and maintenance of said lines.
