Gentlemen:

The Harriman Utility Board finds it necessary to build a 13200 volt, three phase power line across your property in order to serve the needs of the City of Harriman.

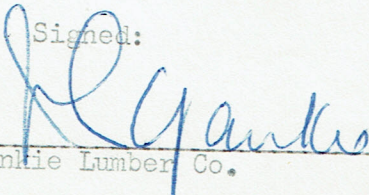
Your property we understand can be roughly described as follows: Bounded on the North-west by Margrave Street or road that extends toward Emory River; bounded on the North-east by H & NE RR Company's property; bounded on the South-east by lands belonging to J. W. Wells, et UX Ruth A. Wells; and bounded on the South-West by land belonging to W H B T Radio Company, all within the City limits of Harriman, Tennessee.

The Line will be constructed as now staked out, with Harriman Utility Board using no poles shorter than 45 foot length, said extra height being used to permit additional circuits to be placed on this same pole line in the future should there be an extreme urgency necessitating the removal of the present power line which has been across the property for several years and known as the Clinch Substation feed line.

Ingress and egress rights are hereby given by the Yankie Lumber Company to the Harriman Utility Board, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain this said power line.

Signatures affixed at the bottom of this contract letter of agreement shall be evidence of agreement as set out above by both parties.

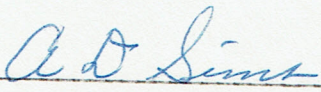
