RIGHT-OF-WAY PERMIT

For and in consideration of One Dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, _____ hereby grant and convey unto The Tennessee Electric Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate, repair, patrol and maintain one line of poles including all necessary wires, anchors, guys, braces, fixtures and appliances for the transmission and distribution of electric current upon, over and across the property which J own, in the Just Civil District of Roane County, Tennessee, said property being described as follows:

Bounded on the north by Ellis
Bounded on the east by Emory Lewis
Bounded on the south by Nichols
Bounded on the west by Nichols

Said sum is accepted in full payment for said rights and also for the right to trim or remove such trees and underbrush from said property as, in the judgment of said Company's agents, may in any way interfere with the construction of said line or endanger the same or the operation thereof when erected. Included in the rights conveyed for said consideration are rights of ingress and egress over said property for the purpose of exercising and using the other rights hereby granted.
